Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed the original telephone records from January 1, 1985 through July 31, 1986 which you forwarded to me by your letter of April 10, 1989.

Please refer to my letter to Roger of March 30, 1989 in which I requested the bank records of Sports Images, Inc. and Hit King Marketing, Inc. from Star Bank also known as First National Bank. Mr. Rose was a signatory on the accounts and co-signed notes in 1987 for loan proceeds ostensibly for those enterprises. I request Mr. Rose obtain copies of all of the records from the bank pertaining to the transactions with these enterprises and forward them to me as soon as possible.

I have now received the Oak Hills Savings and Loan records for 1985, November 1986 to January 1989. I am missing January 1986 through October 1986. These records should have been kept for tax purposes. It is simply inexplicable that these records are missing given the manner in which Mr. Chaiken keeps Mr. Rose's records. All of the previous account statements and checks for each are kept in green folders


